Pool Safety

- Please make sure children are supervised at all times.
- Even older kids and adults should not swim alone. Accidents can happen to anyone and having another person present can be life saving.
- Please do not consume beverages while in the pool.
- A good swim after a hard days work can be very refreshing, but please make use of the shower first. Dirt, sweat and oil from your body can mess up the pool chemistry and cause a pool shutdown.
- If you are going to bring your baby in the pool, please use the proper diaper cover to insure that they do not leak in the pool. Not following this procedure can cause fecal contamination and thus a pool shutdown.

Activity Concerns

These activities have been reported and they are worth mentioning so that we can all be aware and keep an eye out for similar incidents.

- On more than one occasion, there has been a car abandoned in the playground parking area. The cars were at some time later removed. The park closes at 10:00 pm, so no cars should be in the park after that time.
- It was also noted on one occasion that a travel trailer used the park as a stay over. Again, this should not happen.
- Please do not share your gate code. There has been at least one incident where a gate code was shared resulting in non residents gaining access to our facilities. If you think that your gate code has been compromised, let us know immediately and we will change your code.

Other than those three concerns, no questionable activity has been reported.

With summer here, there will be a lot more activity in the park, so lets all do our best to keep the park clean for all to enjoy.
